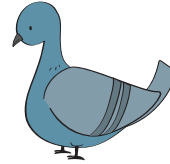

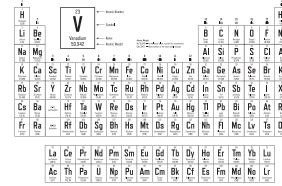

Students who are able to use context clues to define words have higher reading comprehension skills overall. Five different techniques exist for discovering the meaning of words in context.</p> <p>Many times, words that are unfamiliar have either synonyms or antonyms within the same sentence. Authors do this especially when they are introducing difficult vocabulary. If the vocabulary word has a synonym or antonym within the same sentence, the word is usually set off by commas.</p> <p>Authors often hide the meaning of difficult words in a passage within the sentence itself or in the sentence following the difficult word. Students may be able to find a direct definition for the difficult word by simply looking at the sentence for clues to its meaning. For example, by looking at the sentence "George Washington traversed the Delaware River by crossing it under cover of darkness," you notice that another meaning of the word "traversed" is to cross.</p> <p>You may also be able to substitute a word within a sentence for the difficult word. 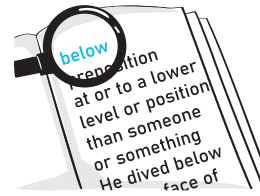

Every three months, the Oxford English Dictionary (OED) adds new words, tenses, and subentries to the language.</p> <p>Usually, the end of the calendar year is when the Oxford English Dictionary and Merriam-Webster Dictionary introduce their "word of the year," choosing an especially important, newish word that has been used in the majority of conversations of the year. But 2020 was in many ways a year unlike any other, something the Oxford English Dictionary reflected in its choice to not choose: There was no word of the year for the dictionary. Instead, it released a larger report called "Words of an Unprecedented Year."</p> <p>After looking into the data of word lookups, it became apparent that 2020 was not a year that could be easily described with one single "word of the year". Most notable, of course, was the coronavirus and its related terms about science, lockdowns, and the new reality of work, school, and isolating.</p> <p>All and all, Words are so interesting for everyone, from what they convey to the feelings and thoughts <u>they</u> inspire. Some may jog memories of incidents or events long past, while others forgotten throughout the years may be completely new to some. When used correctly, a single word can soften a problematic situation. Zoos are popular attractions for adults and children alike. But are they actually a good thing? Those who are against zoos believe that animals deserve respect just like humans, and would argue that animals often suffer physically and mentally by being enclosed. Even the best artificial environments can't come close to matching the space, diversity, and freedom that animals have in their natural homes. 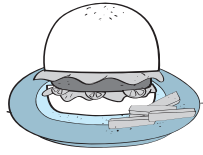

The country of Australia has a vast area of land called "the outback," where few people live. If you live in the outback, chances are you're far from any town. The planet's climate has constantly been changing over thousands of years. The global average temperature today is about 15°C. Scientists are worried that the planet is warming faster than ever before. The 20 warmest years on record have been in the past 22 years, according to the World Meteorological Organization. If this trend continues, temperatures may rise by 3–5°C by 2100.

Scientists say we should try and stop this trend and not allow the average global temperature to rise more than 1.5°. But even a 2°C rise would be bad for us all. Now, half a degree doesn't sound like much – but it could make a big difference to the planet. A 2°C rise would mean that all the coral reefs would disappear, but a 1.5°C rise means that there would still be some. Also, 18 percent of the insects on Earth will disappear if the temperature goes up by 2°C, compared to 6 per cent disappearing at 1.5°C. Thirty-eight per cent of people will be affected by dangerous heat waves at 2°C. That's twice the number compared to at a 1.5°C rise.

So, what can we do? Scientists say that carbon will have to be sucked out of the air by machines and stored underground and that these devices exist already. They also say that billions of trees will have to be planted. People should buy less meat. And, of course, using transport that doesn't burn fossil fuels, like electric cars. It's even better to walk or ride a bike.

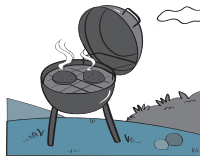

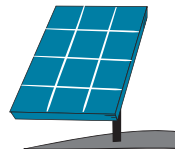
